#### **EMERGENCY SHELTERS**

##### ***ASAP Family Shelters***

Provides temporary shelter from one night to 30 days to intact families with children. Must obtain job within 7 days. Intake is 8:30am – 2pm M-F. Must have picture ID, Social Security card & letter verifying homeless status.

##### ***ASAP Women & Children's Shelter***

423 11<sup>th</sup> Ave. South, St. Petersburg

Provides shelter for single women, single women with 1 child under the age of 11. Intake is 8:30am – 2pm M-Thurs. Must have picture ID, SS# card & homeless verification form. Agency referral preferred.

Provides outpatient temporary care with limited pharmacy options for those who are not eligible for medical care elsewhere including not eligible for Medicare, Medicaid or county health programs, and who are without adequate income for private medical care. No appt is necessary, but it is advisable to call ahead for doctor availability.
